



Hotel Columbia SPA Regulation

- The HOTEL COLUMBIA SPA is also open to the external public.
- Depending on the seasonal flows, the Management reserves the right to reduce the opening hours and days.
- Children under 16 years of age are not allowed to enter.
- To maintain an atmosphere of harmony and relax, guests are invited to speak softly and not to use cell phones.
- At the entrance, the body temperature of everyone is tested, a form regarding privacy and health must be filled out.
- By accessing the SPA, the guest takes full responsibility for his/her own state of health.
- Inside the SPA, an interpersonal distance of 1 meter must be maintained.
- Inside the SPA, guests are required to use a face mask in the common areas.
- Access to the Sauna is allowed to a maximum of 6 people at a time.
- Due to the anti Covid-19 regulations in force, the access to the Steam Bath is not allowed.
- The Jacuzzi can be used at the same time only by people living together or occupying the same room or by people who, according to current regulations, are not subject to interpersonal distancing. This last aspect relates to individual responsibility.
- The Management declines all responsibilities for accidents or damages to people and/or things occurring in the SPA area caused by the imprudence of customers.
- Before and after the use of the deck chairs, it is mandatory to sanitize them using the products made available by the Management.
- During the use of the saunas, at the end of the relax pauses, customers are asked to free the deck chairs from the towels. If the towels are left on the beds, they will be hung on the hooks by our staff.
- To ensure the availability of massages and treatments, we kindly ask you to book them in advance.
- Appointments booked and not canceled at least 24 hours before the treatment will in any case be charged.
- Animals are not allowed into the SPA.
